ROLLAND TOWNSHIP FIRE PROTECTION AND EMERGENCY SERVICES MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the expired previously voted tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution on General Ad Valorem Taxes within Rolland Township be approved at 1 mil (\$1 per \$1000 of taxable value) and levied for a period of 10 years, 2025 – 2034 inclusive?

The purpose of this levy is to provide funds for fire protection and emergency medical services, equipment, capital and other operating expenses.

FREMONT TOWNSHIP OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

Shall the Township of Fremont, beginning in December of 2025 be empowered to levy on all real and personal property within the Township as a renewed millage 1 mill (\$1.00 per \$1,000 of taxable value) estimated to provide the Township in the first calendar year with a revenue of \$64,295 if the millage is approved and levied for a period of up to ten (10) years for the purpose of funding the General Fund within the Township of Fremont, Isabella County? This is a renewal, not an additional millage request.
